I Kings 19: 19 – 21 and II Kings 2: 1 – 15

- I. Your Potential is a Valuable Identification (1 Kings 19: 19 – 21)
  - A. Bless your child with the gift of an involved father
  - B. Be careful who or what you follow
  - C. Break up anything preventing you from your preferred future
  
- II. You are Promised a Vision of your Inheritance (2 Kings 2: 1 - 14)
  - A. In spite of less than desirable attitudes, Elijah suffered from:
    - 1. dealing with a dysfunctional female (Jezebel wanted to kill him)
    - 2. depression (became suicidal and hid in a cave)
    - 3. delusional (thought he was the only one left serving the Lord)
  - B. In spite of discouraging advice
  - C. In spite of difficult actions, Elijah may have had some:
    - 1. misplaced priorities
    - 2. misguided method of protection
    - 3. missing paternal role model
  
- III. You'll become a Powerful Vehicle of Inspiration (2 Kings 2: 15)
  - A. Make a bold request (v. 10)
  - B. Fulfill a broader responsibility (v. 15)
  - C. Expect a blessed result!
    - ( Elijah performed 8 miracles but Elisha performed double)
